## Acre Testing

Miss Murray will give the 5th grade students the ACRE test the week of February 5th. The ACRE test helps educators in Catholic schools and parishes know the strengths and weaknesses of their catechetical programs. This integrated assessment tool provides faith knowledge questions (cognitive domain) and questions related to religious beliefs, attitudes, practices and perceptions (affective domain).
