Spelling Words: make take came game gate late chin graph some today

Religion: Naming those in the Holy Family, identifying the Three Persons in the Trinity, memorization of the Glory Be, the Hail Mary, the Our Father

Phonic skills: Adding -es to words, a-e words, contractions

Reading skills: Story elements, main idea and details, making and confirming predictions, using commas in a series

English skills: Identifying common/proper nouns, identifying singular and plural nouns, prepositions/object of the preposition, correct use of the "Question/Answer Flow"

Math skills: Identifying and counting coins, finding the line of symmetry, addition/subtraction facts, story problems, correctly writing number sentences both vertically and horizontally

Science/Social Studies skills: reading a simple map, understanding the compass rose, nocturnal and diurnal animals, the First Thanksgiving, Pilgrims and the Wampanoag tribe
