### **Nicene Creed**

And by the Holy Spirit was incarnate of the Virgin Mary, and became man. For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who has spoken through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen

**Memorare**

Remember of most gracious Virgin Mary that never was it known that anyone who fled to your protection, implored your help, or sought your intercession was left unaided. Inspired by this confidence, I fly unto to you, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother. To you I come, before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word incarnate despise not my petitions, but in your mercy, hear and answer me. Amen.

**Angelus**

The angel spoke God's message to Mary.

Response: And she conceived of the Holy Spirit. (Hail Mary)

"I am the lowly servant of the Lord

Response: let it be done to me according to Your word." (Hail Mary)

And the word became flesh

Response: and lived among us. (Hail Mary)

Pray for us, Holy Mother of God

Response: that we

may become worthy of the promises of Christ.

Let us pray, Lord, fill our hearts with your Grace: once, through the message of an angel you revealed to us the incarnation of your son; now, through His suffering and death lead us to the glory of His resurrection.. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
