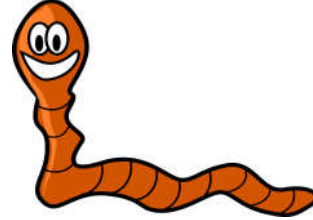
Reading - We have been reviewing main idea and multiple meaning words. Our next story is "Roadrunner's Dance."
